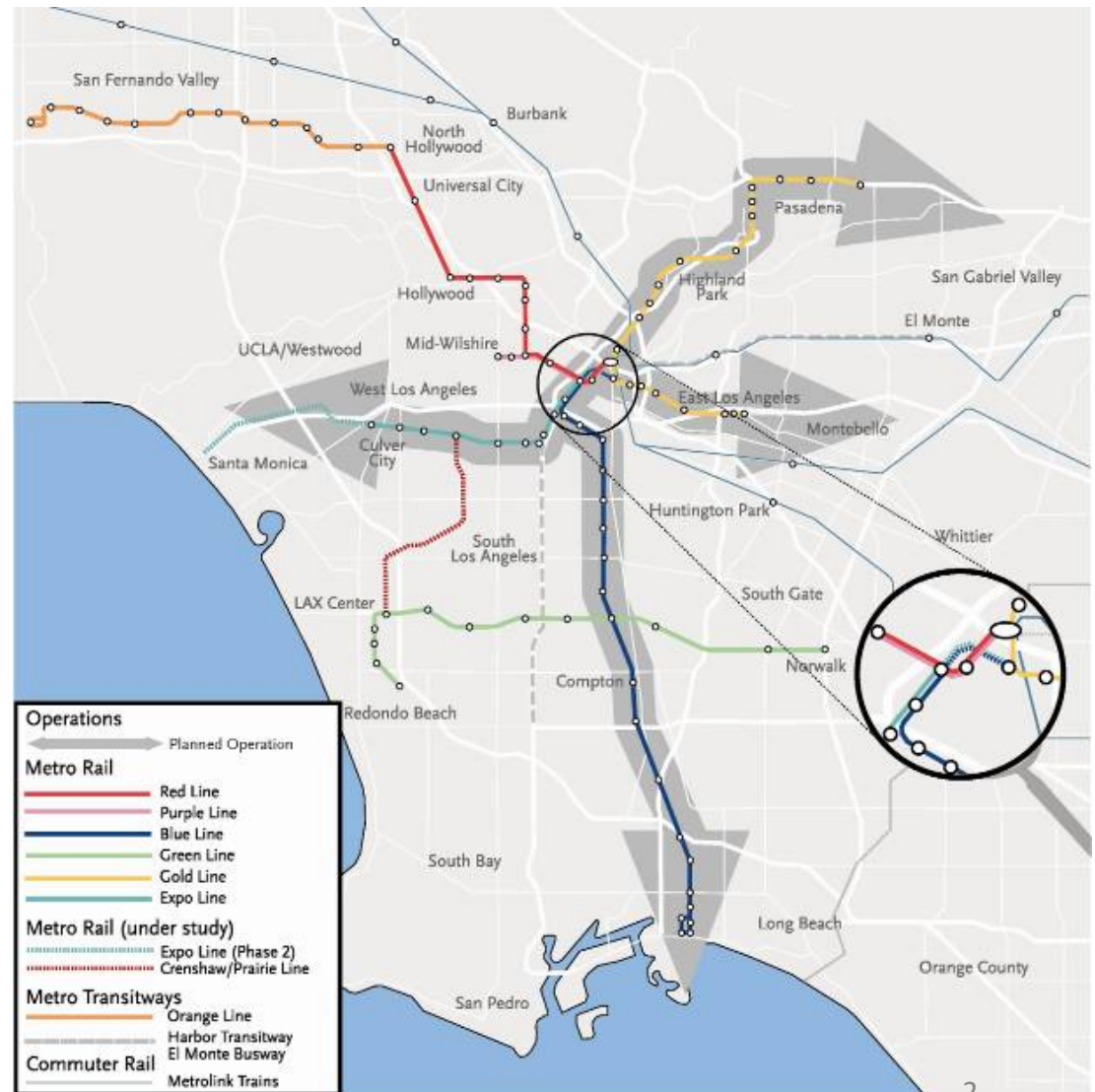
Technical Advisory Committee Update – February 2, 2011



Project Overview

By 2035, the following corridors will have selected projects operational as funded by Measure R and other eligible local, state, and federal funds:

- > Regional Connector
- > Westside Extension
- > Eastside Extension Phase 2
- > Crenshaw-Prairie
- > Foothill Extension
- > Connects the Metro Gold (Pasadena and Eastside), Exposition, and Blue Lines
- > Provides a “One Seat Ride” for travel across Los Angeles County on light rail transit
- > Provides for a sustainable mode of transportation, saving people time and money



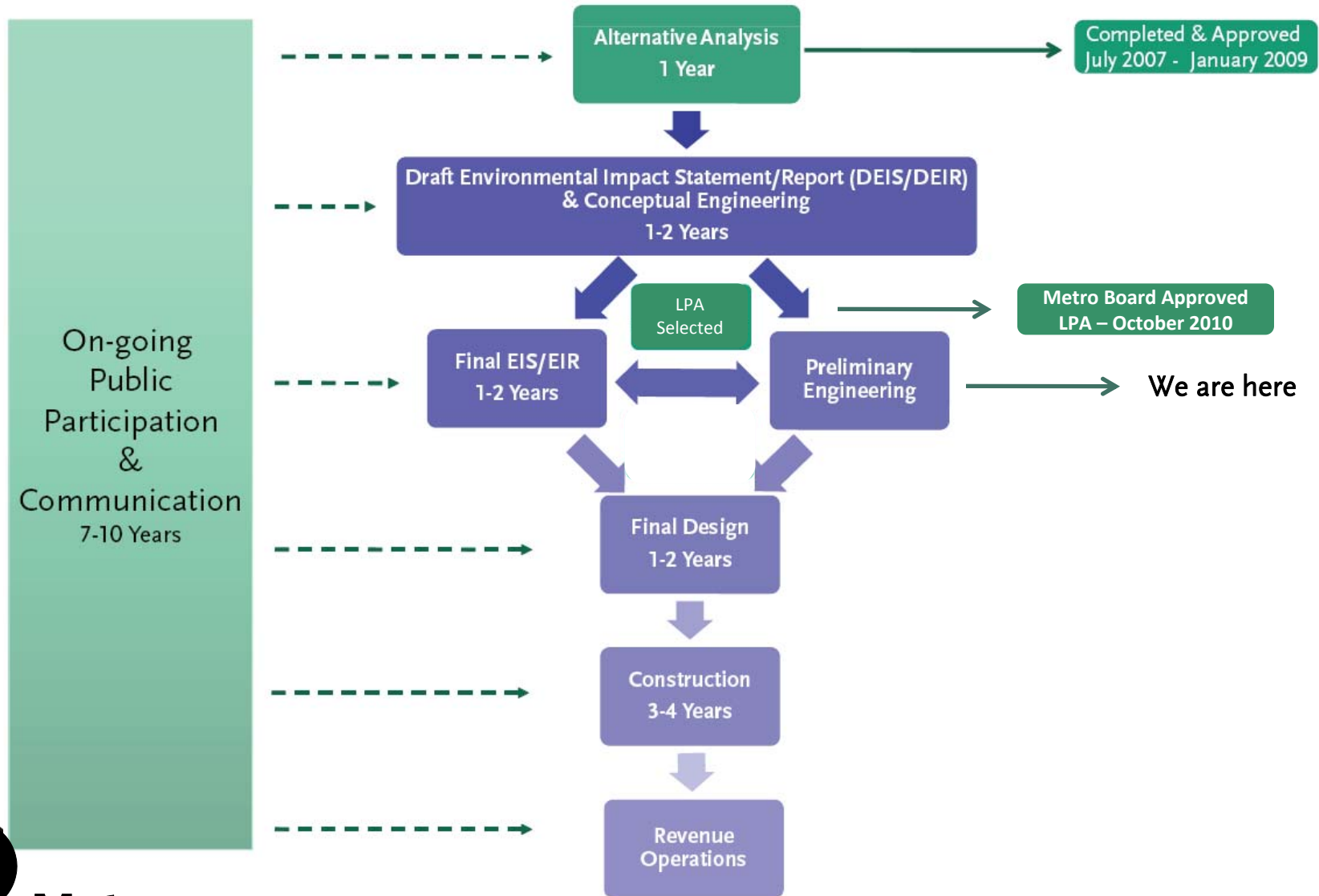
Funding and Cost

- > Cost of the project
 - > The Regional Connector is estimated at \$1.367 billion
- > Funding Assumptions
 - > 60% or \$820 million is being requested from the federal New Starts program
 - > Remaining 40% or \$547.3 million is funded through a combination of State (\$266.5 million), Measure R (\$160.8 million), and other local (\$120 million)

Locally Preferred Alternative



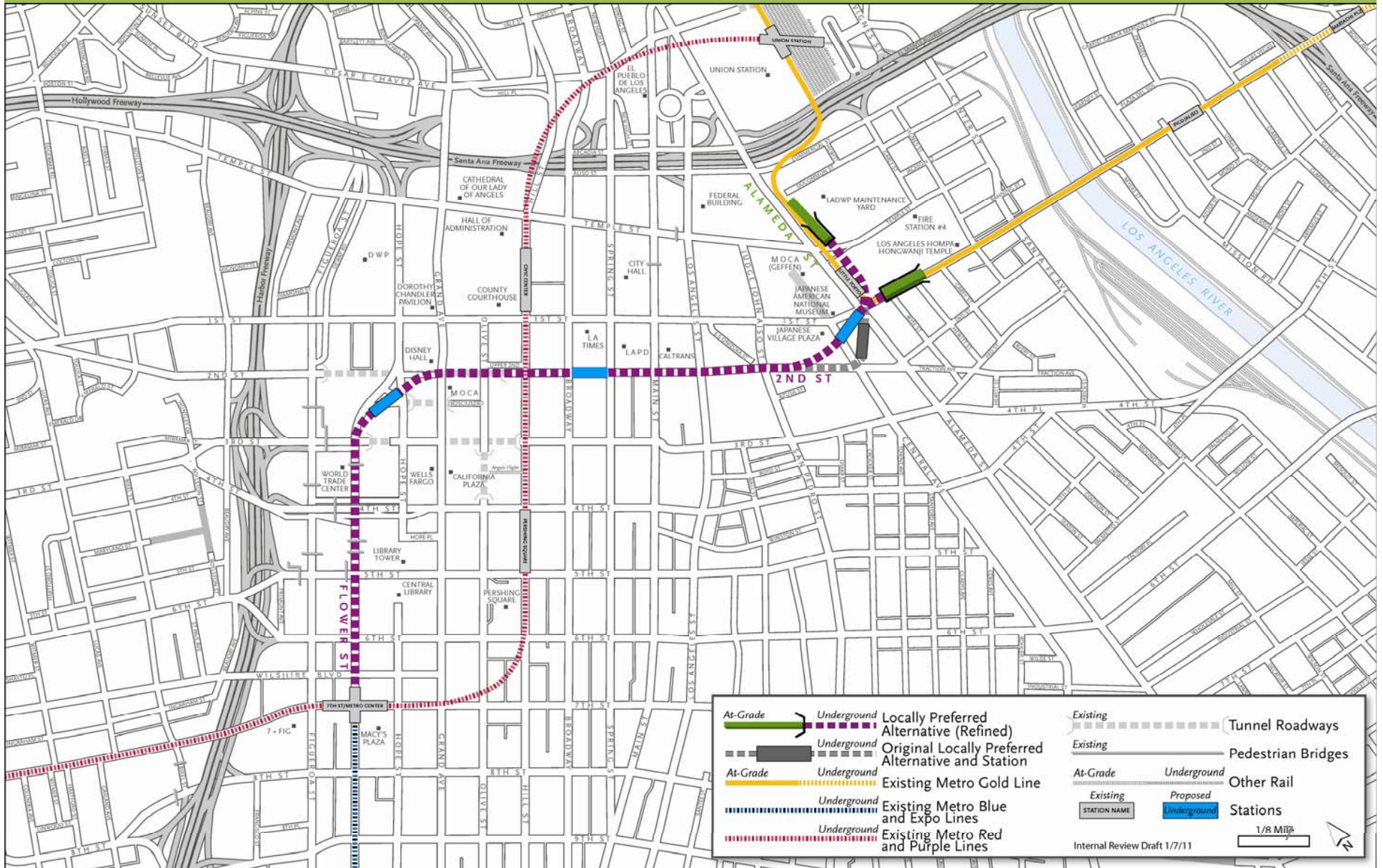
Project Development Process



Purpose of Final EIS/EIR and PE

- > Final EIS/EIR
 - > Respond to Draft EIS/EIR comments
 - > Work with the PE team to minimize environmental impacts through design
 - > Develop Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan
- > Preliminary Engineering (PE)
 - > Support the Final EIS/EIR process in addressing environmental impacts through design
 - > Refine station design/access
 - > Refine cost estimates

Refined Locally Preferred Alternative

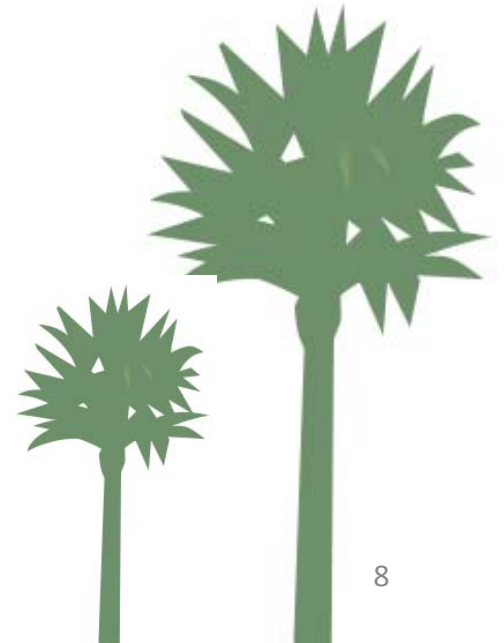
