Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension

- Grand Opening to Public –
November 15, 2009
 - 7-minute service between Union Station and Atlantic with 3-car trains; 12-minute service between Sierra Madre Villa and Union Station with 2-car trains; total of 47 cars in-service.
 - 450 Metro personnel deployed for Crowd Control
 - Mariachi Festival
 - Thousands of people come out to enjoy a free ride and special events

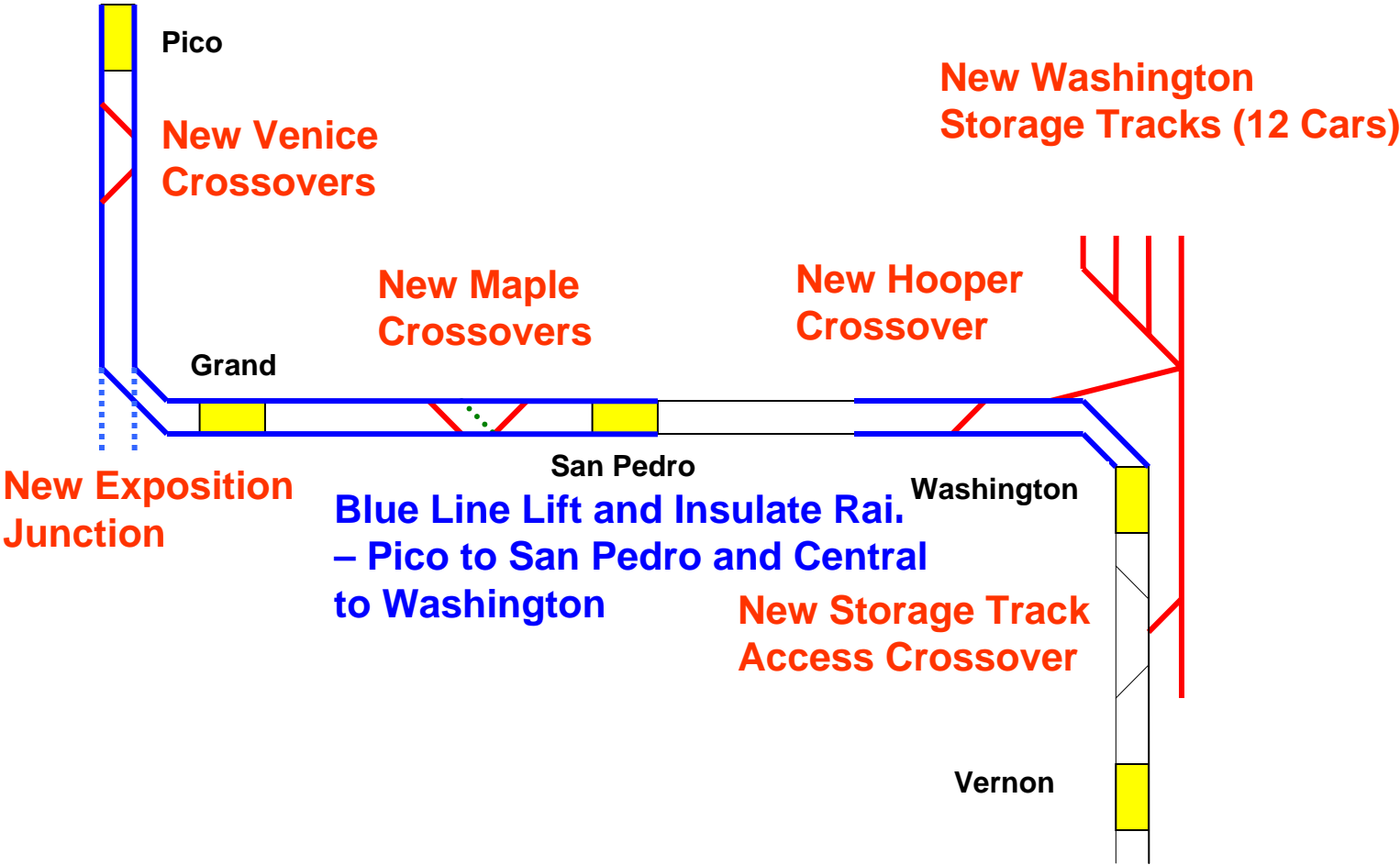
Blue Line Grade Crossing Rehabilitation

- Greenleaf Ave. – October 23-24-25 (completed)
- 21 of the 25 crossings included in this project have been completed.

Myrrh, Alondra, Wilmington, and Florence remain to be completed.

Exposition Line / Blue Line Update

From Washington to 7th St./Metro Center

Phase 1 - Rail Insulation work began on June 28 Thru February

- Single Track between Washington and 7th St./Metro Center (SU-TH)
- Track bed conditions have required repairs
- Parallel train control and OCS duct bank work has started

Phase 2 – Special Track & Overhead Catenary in November & January (5 Weekends)

- Friday 9pm thru Sunday (1AM Monday)
- Bus Bridge

Weekend #1 – November 20-22. Buses will be used from Washington Station to service San Pedro, Grand, Pico and 7th St./Metro Center Stations. Personnel from Rail Ops., Bus Ops., Customer Information, LASD and Metro Security to provide assistance to passengers.

Weekend #2 – January, specific date to be determined.

Phase 3 – 12-car Storage Yard (Downsized)

- Car Wash, Inspection Building and Car Cleaning Platform have been eliminated from project. Until the new Expo Yard is constructed, all trains will need to be cleaned at the Long Beach Yard.
- Special Track & Overhead Catenary planned for February-March (3 Weekends)
- Friday 9pm thru Sunday (1AM Monday)
- Bus Bridges from Vernon to San Pedro
