BENCH CONTRACT****RECOMMENDATION**

- A. Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to establish a qualified list of candidates for Bench Contracts under Request For Interests and Qualifications (RFIQ) PS-4010-2540 to the contractors recommended in Attachment A for a three year period beginning on November 1, 2010 for professional services not to exceed a cumulative total value of \$8 million; and
- B. Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute Task Orders under the individual Bench Contracts for up to \$250,000 per contract.

RATIONALE

The Highway Programs Department requires assistance with professional services in planning, design of multimodal projects, environmental assessments, public outreach services, project management support, and surveying services to assist with moving projects forward in a timely basis.

Award of Architectural & Engineering Task Orders will be based on the technical superiority of a Contractor's proposal in response to a specific scope of work. Award of non-Architectural & Engineering Task Orders will be made competitively to the highest rated contractor with price being a consideration. Staff will ensure that all task orders are in compliance with any and all Small Business requirements.

The Highway Bench will allow staff to award projects in a shorter time period since the procurement process and qualification reviews have already been completed. In addition, by authorizing the CEO's approval authority to award contracts from the Bench at \$250,000 will allow for expediting the procurement of many smaller projects. Many of the projects listed in the categories are smaller-scale projects that once identified as needed, must be initiated and completed in a relatively short period of time to achieve

the maximum benefit of the bench. Some projects might be integral parts of or complimentary work to larger projects that are required to be completed within the schedule constraints of the larger projects.

Background

Currently, there is a Planning Bench Contract that has been utilized over the last six years and has proven to be a very successful method in reducing staff resources expended on the procurement of service contracts and has allowed for projects to be completed in a more efficient manner. The current contract is for three years with two one year options with an authorized contract amount is \$20 million with task orders of up to \$500,000.

Due to the success of the Planning Bench, a Highway Bench with focus towards smaller businesses would be very beneficial to the agency. This will also assist the agency in meeting the goal of 25% participation for DBE/SBE firms. As with the Planning Bench, this will also reduce staff resources needed to expedite the procurement of these service contracts and allow for a more efficient process as well.

The Highway Bench RFIQ offered contractors six disciplines to submit proposals on. Overall, there were 106 proposals received by 75 contractors with 62 of them being recommended for selection on the Highway Bench.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funding has been included in the Highway Programs FY11 budget in numerous cost centers and projects. Each task order that is assigned to a contractor will be funded with the source of funding for tasks being performed from that project. Since this is a multi-year contract, the cost center manager and the Executive Director, Highway Programs will be responsible for budgeting this cost in future years.

Impact to Bus and Rail Operating and Capital Budget

The funding for these projects is dependent upon the specific project. Generally Prop A, C, TDA Administration funds are used for planning activities which are not eligible for bus or rail operating and capital expenditures. In addition, Measure R funds which have been allocated to designated projects will be used as well.


ALTERNATIVE CONSIDERED

The Board could choose not to approve the recommendations; however, award of these task orders would then be pursued as a separate procurement and would have to follow the procurement cycle which could potentially take up to six months. This alternative is not recommended because many of these task orders assist in achieving Metro's initiatives within tight schedule constraints. Also, project costs have increased over the past several years and funding has become limited; therefore, we need to continue to be innovative with administrative processes in order to complete projects in a timely and cost effective manner.



- Any Architect and Engineering Task Order requirement will be competed among bench firms qualified for that skill set, and each of the qualified firms will be sent an RFP for that specific Task Order requirement. After submittal of the technical proposal for evaluation, the most qualified competitor is selected and will be requested to submit a Firm Fixed Price, MTA Form 60 cost proposal. The proposal must be compliant with the DBE/SBE goals set forth in the RFP.
- For non - Architect and Engineering (A&E) Task Order proposals, the initial procedure is the same as the preceding paragraph. The difference is that the Task Order award will be made competitively, to the lowest evaluated bidder, with price being a consideration.

- Each Bench contractor will have expertise in a minimum of one of the following disciplines:
 1. General Planning services
 2. Design Planning services
 3. Environmental Planning services
 4. Public Outreach services
 5. Project Management services
 6. Survey services
- Price fair and reasonableness determination will be made for each Task Order at the time of release.
- Proposers were encouraged to form teams that include Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) / Small Business Enterprise (SBE) firms to perform the scope of work identified within the DBE's/SBE's discipline without schedules or specific dollar commitments prior to establishment of the Highway Program Planning and Deliverables Bench.
- Each Contract as a part of this Bench have both a 35% Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Anticipated Level of Participation (DALP) and a 35% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal.
- The Diversity & Economic Opportunity Department (DEOD) will determine DALP or SBE contract-specific participation goal upon review of each task order issued for projects on the Highway Programs Planning and Deliverables Bench. DALP and SBE participation Bench participant's attainment by task order will be cumulatively credited towards the contract-specific goals. The DALP or SBE goal will be established based on the estimated dollar value for each task order, the funding source, the scope of work, and any subcontracting opportunities.

If federal funding is used for a task order, a DALP participation percentage may be established. Bench firms are advised that if a DALP percentage is established, obtaining the DALP percentage is encouraged but is not a condition of award or an issue of responsiveness.

If state and or local funding is used for a task order, a SBE goal will be established. Bench firms must either achieve the SBE goal set forth in the proposal, or, if the goal is not achieved, document to Metro's satisfaction that good faith efforts (GFE) requirements were conducted.

C. Evaluation of Proposals

- Competitive qualification statements were sought and reviewed by a Source Selection committee. They were evaluated for qualifications and technical competency to perform the required work in the specific disciplines proposed.

- The RFIQ contained neither price nor a specific Statement of Work. Each future contract/Task Order will contain a specific Statement of Work, which will be sent to all Bench consultants qualified in that specific survey area. The Bench contractors will propose according to the requirements of the RFP.
- Placement on the Bench will not guarantee an award of any contract/Task Order.

D. Cost/Price Analysis Explanation of Variances

- This Section is not applicable to the Bench contracts. Cost/Price analysis will be performed, as appropriate, on resultant Task Order releases.
