Draft Regional Service Council By-Laws

With the end of Service Sectors, by-laws needed to be changed to reflect

- No more General Managers
- No direct division responsibilities

This offers an opportunity to strengthen the role of Councils

- Combine by-laws and policy documents into one item
- Increase Council service review and approval roles



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Proposed Significant Changes

- **Change title to Regional Service Councils**
- **Officially change bus line responsibility from divs. to region**
- **Councils are fully responsible for all service changes including Tier 1**
 - **Metro Board to review approved changes on an information only basis**
- **Expect Council Reps. to ride public transit on a monthly basis**
- **Adjust all terms to begin on July 1**
- **Adjust terms so that 3 Reps. terms end each year**

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Proposed Significant Changes Cont.

- **Increases Council's role in reviewing major capital projects for comments**
- **Increases Council's role in reporting Metro service quality**
- **Increases Council's role in Metro Rail service issues**
- **Acknowledges the position of Director of Regional Service Councils**
- **Requires an annual work plan for each Council by July**
- **Councils to provide annual input to Deputy CEO re: Director's performance**

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Next Steps

- **Council comments and recommendations will be considered in developing final version of by-laws**
- **The Revised by-laws will be presented to Metro Board of Directors Executive Management and Audit Committee in January 2011**
