A layover for a mass transit line refers to the break the driver or the vehicle is given at the end of a trip before it starts operating its reverse route or before beginning its next trip. A well-positioned layover minimizes “dead running” of buses, helps the bus system run efficiently and reduces congestion and emissions. There is a Metro bus layover currently situated on La Loma Road and Figueroa Street in Eagle Rock. This location is no longer conducive to a bus layover and is an impediment to economic development at the adjacent shopping center. In order for the neighborhood Vons to expand, the bus layover must be relocated.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Board direct the CEO to relocate the current bus layover on La Loma Road and Figueroa Street in Eagle Rock to Colorado Boulevard east of Figueroa Street or another appropriate location.
