

Notice of Night Work Activity

I-405 Sepulveda Pass Widening Project

ATTENTION COMMUTERS, RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF THE SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (I-405) BETWEEN WILSHIRE BLVD. AND SUNSET BLVD.

As part of the pre-construction activities for the I-405 Sepulveda Pass Widening Project, the Contractor is required to ensure that the drainage system along the freeway is clean and clear. Beginning the night of Monday, April 5, 2010, Closed Circuit TV (CCTV) cameras will be used to document the existing conditions of the drainage system on the freeway and ramps. Drains will be cleaned and the grates will be welded down.

What: Drainage system condition documentation on southbound I-405 from Sunset Blvd to Olympic Blvd; and southbound Wilshire Blvd. on and off-ramps and Sunset Blvd. off-ramp.

When: Night time work will begin Monday, April 5, 2010, for one night only. This activity will take place between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Where: Southbound I-405 #5 lane from Sunset Blvd to Olympic Blvd; closure of southbound Wilshire Blvd on and off-ramps and Sunset Blvd. off-ramp.

What to Expect:

- Southbound I-405 will remain open to thru traffic
- Southbound Wilshire Blvd ramps closed, Sunset Blvd off-ramp closed.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
