

Notice of Night Work Activity

I-405 Sepulveda Pass Widening Project

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND COMMUTERS IN THE VICINITY SKIRBALL CENTER DRIVE AND GETTY CENTER DRIVE

As part of the pre-construction activities for the I-405 Sepulveda Pass Widening Project, the Contractor is required to ensure that the drainage system along the freeway is clean and clear. On the night of Monday, April 5th, Closed Circuit TV (CCTV) cameras will be used to document the existing conditions of the drainage system on the southbound on and off-ramps at Skirball Center Drive and the southbound on-ramp at Getty Center Drive. Drains may also be cleaned and the grates may be welded down. These southbound ramps will remain open and accessible to and from the I-405 freeway.

What: Drainage system condition documentation on the southbound on and off-ramps at Skirball Center Drive and the southbound on-ramp at Getty Center Drive.

When: Night time work will take place on Monday, April 5th, for one night only. This work activity will take place between 9:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

Where: The southbound on and off-ramps at Skirball Center Drive and the southbound on-ramp at Getty Center Drive.

What to Expect:

- The southbound on and off-ramps at Skirball Center Drive and the southbound on-ramp at Getty Center Drive will remain open and accessible to and from the freeway.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
