ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF THIRD STREET AND FORD AVENUE

Beginning Monday, January 22, 2007, the contractor will re-stripe Third Street (between Ford Ave. and McDonnell Ave.). Following the re-striping, traffic will be pushed to the north side of the street. This is necessary for the contractor to begin working on the street restoration of the south side of Third St.

What: Re-striping, traffic switch

When: Beginning Monday, January 22, 2007, the re-striping of the street will be for one night only. The traffic switch will be in place for approximately three months.

Where: Third Street between Ford Ave and McDonnell Ave.

What to Expect: During this phase of construction, the following impacts can be anticipated:

- Traffic lane reductions.
- Cones and arrow boards will be used to redirect traffic and to minimize impacts to the community.
- Access to all homes and businesses will be maintained.
- Pedestrians will be redirected to the north side of the street.
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
