Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1st Street between Cheesbroughs and Alma

The Contractor for the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) will soon begin utility relocation of SBC telephone lines on 1st Street between Cheesbroughs and Alma. As part of this process, the crews will excavate trenches to relocate the telephone lines to new locations. This is all in preparation for the continued construction of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension.

What: Utility Relocation

When: This activity will begin Friday, March 17, 2006 and will continue for approximately six weeks, weather permitting. The work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 3:30pm.

Where: On 1st Street between 50' west of Cheesbroughs and Alma.

What to Expect: Construction crews will be involved in excavation of trenches, hauling of materials, laying of large pipes, backfilling and resurfacing along 1st Street using mechanical excavators, cranes and trucks.

Intermittent lane closures

While the street will never be fully closed, there will be intermittent lane closures for the eastbound and westbound traffic on 1st Street between Cheesbroughs and Alma.

Intermittent parking restrictions

Associated with the lane closures, will be parking restrictions on the north side of 1st Street to allow safe access for the construction and to keep the public safe and traffic moving as much as possible.
