ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF ALAMEDA/TEMPLE

The Contractor for Metro will begin the installation of new utilities on Alameda between Temple and Banning. The first order of work will entail re-striping of Alameda between Temple and Banning to push the traffic westerly. The next phase of the work will primarily be on the east side of Alameda and will consist of the installation of new utilities.

What: Restriping of Alameda and installation of new utilities on the Easterly side of the street.

When: Beginning April 1, 2006, the work will continue for approximately 12 months, weather permitting. The work hours will be 7:00am-4:00pm, Monday through Friday and intermittent weekends as needed.

Where: Alameda between Temple and Banning (East side).

What to Expect: The public can expect the following during these work activities:

- While traffic lanes on Alameda will not be closed during this work, there will be a reduction in traffic lanes through the work zone.
- Pedestrians may expect to be re-routed to the West side of Alameda.
- Access to businesses will be maintained.
