## **STREET RESTORATION AND TRAFFIC SWITCH ON 1<sup>ST</sup> STREET BETWEEN EVERGREEN AND LORENA**

**As part of the tunnel portal construction for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Project, the Contractor will begin street restoration. This includes installation of a new curb and gutter, installation of new traffic signals on 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Lorena, street paving, and switching the traffic around the East Portal.**

**What: Street Restoration Operation**

**When: This activity will be carried out during the weekend, beginning on Saturday, April 22, 2006. Work will be continuous from Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 6:00am until Monday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, at 6:00am.**

**Where: There will be a full street closure on 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Evergreen and Lorena.**

**What to Expect: The work will involve the installation of a new curb and gutter, installation of a new traffic signal light and street and paving. 1st Street will be re-opened to traffic upon completion of work at 6:00 am, Monday morning.**

**Pedestrian access on the south side of 1<sup>st</sup> Street will be maintained. Flaggers will be available to help pedestrians access their homes and businesses within the closed area. Roving security will be patrolling the area. The north side of 1<sup>st</sup> Street will be closed to both pedestrians and joggers between Fresno and Lorena. Joggers will be turned around at Evergreen and Lorena.**

**Street parking on the south side of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Fresno and Lorena will not be available all weekend. Street parking on the south side of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Fresno and Velasco will not be available during Saturday night ONLY. However, alternative parking will be made available on the north side of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Fresno and Evergreen, and on Lorena.**
