ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF DUCOMMUN STREET

As approved by the Department of Transportation, Ducommun St. has been permanently vacated. The final configuration of Ducommun St. will eliminate the intersection of Ducommun and Alameda. In order to continue with construction of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension (MGL EE), the constructor will relocate utilities and construct a Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) wall. Once this work is complete, they will build a cul-de-sac.

What: Street storm drain, catch basins, junction structures and sanitary sewer relocation

When: Work is scheduled to occur from Monday, June 5, 2006, and will continue for approximately two months. Work hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and 8:00p.m. to 6:00a.m. Monday through Friday, weather permitting. This schedule is subject to change.

Where: Ducommun Street

What to Expect: During this phase of construction activities, the following impacts can be anticipated:

- During night work on Alameda Street lanes will be reduced
- Access to all businesses during this construction activity will be maintained
- Pedestrian access will be redirected to the west side of Alameda Street depending on the construction activities
- Traffic will be detoured off of Ducommun Street
