

Notice of Night Construction

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF FIRST STREET AND VIGNES STREET

Beginning Friday, July 28, 2006, the contractor will excavate to add protection to the existing sewer lines, as well as install new sewer laterals to the homes and businesses along 1st St. from Vignes St. to Alameda St. The work includes installing sanitary sewer encasements at 1st St. and Vignes St., saw cutting and removal of pavement, and the installation of nearly a dozen sewer laterals.

This closure is necessary to access the two existing sanitary sewer facilities that run north-south on Vignes St. and the laterals that will be installed in 1st St. In addition, the Department of Water and Power will install an electrical underground vault at the northwest corner of 1st St./Vignes St.

What: Intersection closure at 1st St. and Vignes St. for sanitary sewer encasement

When: Beginning Friday, July 28, 2006, the work will take place the following weekends: 7/28, 8/4, 8/18, 8/25, and 9/15, weather permitting. The hours of the intersection closure will be 8:00 p.m. Friday thru 6:00 a.m. Monday.

Where: First St. between Alameda St. and Mission Rd. and Vignes St. between Banning St. and 2nd St.

What to Expect: During this phase of construction activities, the following impacts can be anticipated:

- Eastbound traffic will be detoured south on Alameda St. to 4th St. and then north on Anderson St. back to 1st St.
- Westbound traffic will be detoured north on Mission Rd. to Cesar Chavez Ave. and then south on Alameda St. to First St.
- Access to all homes and businesses will be maintained.
- Flaggers will direct traffic for safe transition of construction activities within the public right-of-way.
- Fire department and emergency vehicles access will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the south side of 1st St. between Alameda St. and Mission Rd., and pedestrian access will be maintained on the east side of Vignes St. from Banning St. to 2nd St.
