Attention Business Owners and Residents in the vicinity of Commercial Street between Vignes and Alameda

Caltrans contractors will begin pouring concrete on the bridge structure across the 101 freeway. The pour will begin on the north side of the 101 freeway and progress southerly. Beginning Thursday night, August 24, residents and business owners can expect the following impacts to traffic.

What: Concrete pour

When: This activity will begin on Thursday, August 24, 2006 at 9:00pm and will continue until Friday, August 25th, 10:00am.

Where: The newly constructed bridge structure spanning across the 101 freeway.

What to

Expect: 9:00pm – 1:00am

- Closure of the N/B off ramp of the 101 Freeway to Alameda
- Closure of the 101 N/B on ramp at Vignes
- Closure of the Busway in both directions
- Closure of the #4 lane of the N/B 101 Freeway at 9:00pm and the #3 & 4 lanes at 10:00pm
- 1:00am all N/B lanes, ramps and the busway will be reopened.

1:00am – 6:00am Friday

- Closure of the #3&4 S/B lanes to complete the center concrete pour from the other side of the freeway.

6:00am – 10:00am Friday

- All freeway lanes will be open while the remaining concrete pour will be done using the construction staging areas on the S/B side of the freeway.
