Attention residents and business owners in the vicinity of 1st Street and Mission Road

The Contractor for Metro will begin constructing a gravity retaining wall on west side of Mission Road south of 1st Street. This work is part of the widening of 1st Street Bridge to support the construction of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension.

What: Construction of a gravity retaining wall.

When: This activity will start the week of November 6, 2006, and will continue until approximately January 2007, weather permitting. Approximate work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and possible night work.

Where: West side of Mission Road south of 1st Street.

**What to
Expect:**

- Pedestrians on the west side of Mission Road will be routed to the east side of Mission Road and pedestrians on the south side of 1st Street will be routed to the north side of 1st Street.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Trucks will be prohibited from turning right onto Mission Road from eastbound 1st Street.
- The construction area will be securely fenced off.
- Accessibility to homes and businesses will be maintained.
