Attention residents and business owners in the vicinity of 1st Street from Gless to Pecan

The Contractor for Metro will begin constructing a concrete block retaining wall in Pecan Park and a new sidewalk on the south side of 1st Street between Gless Street and Pecan Street. This work is part of the widening of 1st Street, which is necessary to provide a corridor for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension.

What: Construction of a concrete block retaining wall as an extension of the existing wall in Pecan Park to enable the construction of a new sidewalk and widening of the road pavement above the wall.

When: This activity will start the week of January 10, 2005, weather permitting, and will continue for approximately 8 weeks. Work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Where: Along 1st Street between Gless and Pecan on the south side of 1st Street.

What to Expect: The most southern eastbound lane will be closed during the construction of the concrete block wall to ensure vehicular traffic safety between Clarence and Boyle. The sidewalk on the south side of 1st Street will also be closed intermittently from Clarence to Bodie to ensure pedestrian safety. Pedestrians will be routed to the north side of 1st Street. The construction area will be securely fenced off and public access to Pecan Park will be maintained.
