

Construction Notice

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SOLDIER PILING IN THE VICINITY OF 1ST /BOYLE BETWEEN BOYLE AND BAILEY

The Contractor for Metro will begin the soldier pile operation on the north side of 1st Street between Boyle and Bailey. Soldier piles create the underground structure that supports the excavation, making way for the subsequent stages of station excavation and tunneling. The construction activity will be very similar to what has been going on 1st Street, west of Boyle, over the past few weeks.

What: Soldier Pile Operation

When: This activity will begin the week of January 17, 2005 and will continue for approximately five weeks. Work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7am-6pm.

Where: The north side of 1st Street between Boyle and Bailey.

What to Expect: Two augers will drill 3 foot diameter holes at each of the pile locations at about 7 foot centers. A large crane will then lower a steel beam into the hole, which is then encased in concrete placed directly from a cement mixer truck.

While 1st Street will remain open during this work activity, the parking restrictions on 1st Street will continue. Pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times. During working hours assigned construction personnel will escort business customers and residents safely through the construction area.
