

Construction Notice

Attention residents and business owners in the vicinity of 1st Street from Dacotah to Lorena

The contractor for Metro will begin a series of construction activities in this location in preparation for the future underground construction. Precautions will be taken to ensure pedestrian and vehicular safety.

- What:** The following construction activities will be carried out in sequence.
1. K-rail (concrete barriers) and replacing of road marking in 1st Street. Barriers will be placed on the south side of 1st Street to create a protected work zone for the subsequent construction work described in the following sections 2 to 4. New road markings will be placed to direct the traffic to the northern side of the street during this construction.
 2. Exploratory trenching prior to soldier piling will be done to locate any underground utilities that might be otherwise damaged during soldier piling.
 3. The main waterline will be relocated to accommodate the subsequent construction of the tunnel entrance.
 4. Soldier Piling, which will create the underground structure that supports the excavation for the tunnel entrance, will be undertaken.

When: These activities will begin the week of January 17, 2005 and will continue for approximately 6 weeks. Work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7:00am-6:00pm.

Where: Along 1st Street between Dacotah and Lorena.

What to Expect: During these activities parking along 1st Street between Dacotah and Lorena will be restricted. Alternative parking will be provided to residents and their guests at the Metro lot on the northeast corner of 1st Street and Lorena Street.

Cars parked on 1st Street will be towed.

The construction will involve back-hoes for the trenching and waterline construction and auger drill rigs and cranes for the piling work, as well as cement mixer trucks for miscellaneous concreting works.
