ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF THE EAST PORTAL (1ST STREET BETWEEN FRESNO AND CONCORD) IN BOYLE HEIGHTS

Commencing February 3, 2003

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) will begin advanced utility relocation of gas lines. Gas Company crews will cut and excavate trenches approximately 4 to 6 feet deep to relocate the lines to new locations as part of the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Light Rail Project.

WHAT: Relocation of utilities to preserve them during construction.

WHEN: This activity will begin on February 3, 2003 and will continue for approximately two months. Work hours for this phase will be 9:00am to 3:00pm weekdays only. Some night work may occur if necessary.

WHERE: The utility relocation activity will take place in the alley south of 1st Street between Fresno and Concord.

WHAT TO

EXPECT: Gas Company crews will relocate the utilities by digging through the street surface and moving the gas lines. The contractors will maintain 1 lane of traffic in each direction on Concord Street and must maintain 2 lanes of traffic in eastbound direction on 1st Street with no interference to westbound traffic at all times.
