## Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 3rd Street between Mednik Avenue and Atlantic Boulevard

The Contractor for the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) will soon begin underground utility survey services by excavating potholes, in preparation for the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Light Rail Project. Crews will perform potholing by using air/vacuum soil extraction for the purpose of locating, marking, measuring and recording the exact locations of existing underground utilities.

- What: Underground Utility Survey Services by potholing
- When: This activity will begin on Wednesday, February 23, 2005 and will continue for approximately 3 days. Work hours will be from 7:00am to 5:00pm.
- Where: The potholing activity will take place on 3rd Street between Mednik Avenue and Atlantic Boulevard.
- What to Expect: The crews will pothole through the street surface to identify the position of existing underground utilities. While no street closures will be needed for the potholing, there will be intermittent lane closures at the locations noted below:

<u>Date</u>	<u>Segment</u>	<u>Lane Closures</u>	<u>Parking Restrictions</u>
02.23.05	3 <sup>rd</sup> Street from Fetterly Avenue to La Verne Avenue.	One lane in each direction (east and west bound).	No street parking on 3 <sup>rd</sup> Street from Fetterly to La Verne.
02.24.05	3 <sup>rd</sup> Street from La Verne Avenue to Via Corona.	One lane in each direction (east and west bound) <b>and</b> one lane north and south bound on Via Corona south of 3 <sup>rd</sup> Street.	No street parking from Via Corona to Atlantic on Pomona.
02.25.05	Pomona Boulevard from Via Corona/Woods to Atlantic Boulevard.	One lane in each direction (east and west bound).	No street parking from Via Corona to Atlantic on Pomona.

***The Contractor shall maintain access to all driveways and shall maintain local and emergency access during all work hours. This work will not interfere with pedestrian traffic.***
