**ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF 1ST
STREET AND LORENA**

The Contractor for Metro will continue construction activities at the East Portal. These activities comprise the widening of 1st Street on the north side to accommodate the construction of the tunnel portal itself, the installation of piles for the portal, and the construction of a new retaining wall to the property containing the Los Angeles County Crematorium and new sidewalks.

WHAT: The widening of 1st Street, the installation of piles to the East Portal structure, the construction of a new retaining wall on the north side of 1st Street and reconstruction of the sidewalk and jogging path at the same location.

WHEN: Beginning the week of June 13, 2005 and continuing through mid-September, weather permitting. Work hours for these activities will generally be Monday-Saturday from 7:00am-6:00pm. The one exception to this will be the installation of the piles, which will continue through the weekend on Saturday and Sunday.

WHERE: 1st Street between Fresno and Lorena.

WHAT TO EXPECT: For the most part, 1st Street will remain open to traffic with minor diversions to the south side of the street as approved by LADOT, except for the piling operation. The piling operation is a 7 day a week activity and during the weekend the traffic on 1st Street may be restricted at times to one lane in an easterly direction.

The current jogging path and sidewalk along the north side of 1st Street will be closed during all construction activities. Joggers will be redirected during the temporary closure of this portion of the jogging path. This is for the safety of the joggers. Once these construction activities are completed, the jogging path will be built back to its original condition and reopened.

Parking on the south side of 1st Street will be allowed during most of the construction. Alternative parking will be provided at all times at an allotted area on the northeast corner of 1st/Lorena.
