## **Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between the 101 Freeway and Boyle Avenue**

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) will soon begin advanced utility relocation of CATV (Adelphia Cable). Adelphia Cable crews will excavate trenches to relocate the cable lines to new locations to prepare for the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Light Rail Project.

**What:** Advanced relocation of utilities prior to light rail construction.

**When:** This activity will begin between the week of June 23, 2003 and will continue for approximately one month. Work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and Saturdays from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. This work will not interfere with traffic at any other time.

**Where:** The utility relocation activity will take place on 1<sup>st</sup> Street between the 101 Freeway and Boyle Avenue.

**What to Expect:** Adelphia Cable crews will relocate the utilities by digging through the street surface and moving the cable lines. Traffic lane requirements are as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Street West of Boyle Avenue

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street with no interference to eastbound traffic during work hours.

Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Boyle Avenue

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours.

Boyle Avenue north of 1<sup>st</sup> Street

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the northbound direction on Boyle Avenue with no interference to southbound traffic during work hours.

Pleasant Avenue

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on Pleasant Avenue during work hours.

***The Contractor shall maintain access to all driveways and shall maintain local and emergency access during all work hours. This work will not interfere with pedestrian traffic, except when workers excavate in the crosswalks. Only one sidewalk may be closed at a time.***
