## **Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Mission Road and Pecan Street**

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) will soon begin advanced utility relocation of SBC telephone lines. The SBC Contractor will excavate trenches to relocate the telephone lines to new locations to prepare for the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Light Rail Project.

- What:** Advanced relocation of utilities prior to light rail construction.
- When:** This activity will begin on June 23, 2003 and will continue for approximately six months. Work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and Saturdays from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. This work will not interfere with traffic at any other time.
- Where:** The utility relocation activity will take place on 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Mission Road and Pecan Street.
- What to Expect:** The SBC Contractor will relocate the utilities by digging through the street surface and moving the telephone lines. Traffic lane requirements are as follows:
- Mission Road  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Mission Road during work hours. No interference to Via Las Vegas.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Mission Road and Anderson Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the eastbound direction and two lanes of traffic in the westbound direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street during work hours.
- Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Anderson Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Anderson Street during work hours.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Anderson Street and Pecan Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the eastbound direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street with no interference to westbound traffic during work hours.
- Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Utah Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Utah Street during work hours.
- Via Las Vegas between Anderson Street and Clarence Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic with flagger control on Via Las Vegas during work hours.
- Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Clarence Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Clarence Street during work hours.
- Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Gless Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Gless Street during work hours.
- Pecan Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Pecan Street during work hours.
- The Contractor shall maintain access to all driveways and shall maintain local and emergency access during all work hours. This work will not interfere with pedestrian traffic, except when workers excavate in the crosswalks. Only one sidewalk may be closed at a time.***
