

Construction Notice

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Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1st Street between Bodie Street and Pleasant

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) will soon begin advanced utility relocation of SBC telephone lines. The SBC Contractor will excavate trenches to relocate the telephone lines to new locations to prepare for the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Light Rail Project.

- What:** Advanced relocation of utilities prior to light rail construction.
- When:** This activity will begin in July, and will continue for approximately 6 months. Work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and Saturdays from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. This work will not interfere with traffic at any other time.
- Where:** The utility relocation activity will take place on 1st Street between Bodie Street and Pleasant.
- What to Expect:** The SBC Contractor will relocate the utilities by digging through the street surface and moving the telephone lines. Traffic lane requirements are as follows:
- 1st Street west of Bodie Street
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the eastbound direction on 1st Street with no interference to westbound traffic during work hours.
- Intersection of 1st Street and Bodie Street
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the eastbound direction on 1st Street with no interference to westbound traffic during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Bodie Street during work hours.
- 1st Street between Bodie Street and Boyle Avenue
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours.
- Intersection of 1st Street and Boyle Avenue
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours.
- Boyle Avenue between 1st Street and Pleasant Avenue
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours.
- 1st Street between Boyle Avenue and the alley east of Boyle Avenue
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the eastbound direction on 1st Street with no interference to westbound traffic during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic with flagger control in the alley east of Boyle Avenue during work hours.
- 1st Street between the alley east of Boyle Avenue and east of Bailey Street
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours.
- Intersection of Bailey Street and Pleasant Avenue
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Bailey Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on Pleasant Avenue during work hours.
- Pleasant Avenue between Boyle Avenue and Bailey Street
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on Pleasant Avenue during work hours.
- Intersection of Pleasant Avenue and Boyle Avenue
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Pleasant Avenue during work hours.
- The Contractor shall maintain access to all driveways and shall maintain local and emergency access during all work hours. This work will not interfere with pedestrian traffic, except when workers excavate in the crosswalks. Only one sidewalk may be closed at a time.***
