

Construction Notice

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Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1st Street between Breed Street and Soto Street

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) will soon begin advance power relocation of DWP Power. DWP crews will install 4.8 kv & 34.5 conduit on 1st Street between Breed Street & Soto Street. This work is to prepare for the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Light Rail Project.

What: Advanced power relocation prior to light rail construction.

When: This activity will begin on July 30th, and will continue for approximately 4 months. Work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and/or Saturdays from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. This work will not interfere with traffic at any other time.

Where: The Advanced power relocation activity will take place on 1st Street between Breed Street to Soto Street

What to Expect: DWP crews will relocate the power utilities. Traffic lane requirements are as follows:

Intersection of 1st Street and Breed Street

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Breed Street during work hours.

1st Street between Breed Street and Soto Street

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours. All turning movements shall be prohibited on 1st Street.

Intersection of 1st Street and Soto Street

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Soto Street during work hours.

1st Street between Soto Street and 300' East of Soto Street

The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on 1st Street during work hours. All westbound turning movements shall be prohibited on 1st Street.

The Contractor shall maintain access to all driveways and shall maintain local and emergency access during all work hours. All trenches and excavations shall be either backfilled or steel plated and feathered with asphalt daily so that all traffic and parking lanes are open during non-construction hours.
