

Construction Notice

Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 3rd Street between Mednik Avenue and Atlantic Boulevard

Contractors for various Utility Companies (Cal Water and The Gas Company) will be relocating their facilities in preparation for continued construction of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension. Utilities encroaching the proposed rail alignment will be relocated outside the rail and rail crossings in casings which will be installed.

What: Utility relocation in preparation of light rail construction.

When: This activity will begin the week of Aug 8, 2005 and will continue for approximately six months. Typical work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm.

Where: The utility relocation activity will take place on 3rd Street between South Mednik Avenue and South Atlantic Boulevard.

What to Expect: Utility contractors will be relocating pipelines and installing pipelines in casings to cross the future rail at various locations within these limits. During this work, the public can expect intermittent lane closures and intermittent restrictions on parking lanes.

Traffic Control will be implemented through the use of Standard Plans or County approved Traffic Handling plans when the Standard Plans are not applicable.

All trenches and excavations will be either backfilled or steel plated and feathered with asphalt daily so that all traffic and parking lanes are open during non-construction hours.

The Contractor will maintain access to all driveways and will maintain local and emergency access during all work hours.
