## Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1<sup>st</sup>/Boyle

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) will soon begin advanced utility relocation of gas lines. Gas Company crews will excavate trenches to relocate the lines to new locations to prepare for the future Metro Gold Line Eastside Light Rail Project.

- What:** Advanced relocation of utilities prior to light rail construction.
- When:** This activity will begin September 15 and will continue for approximately 4-6 weeks. Work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and/or Saturdays from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. This work will not interfere with traffic at any other time. Some night work may occur if necessary.
- Where:** The utility relocation activity will take place on 1<sup>st</sup> Street between 101 freeway and State Street.
- What to Expect:** Gas Company crews will relocate the utilities by digging through the street surface and moving the gas lines. This work may involve closing the alley south of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Boyle and State periodically. Traffic lane requirements are as follows:
- 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Bodie Street and Boyle Avenue  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction of 1<sup>st</sup> Street with no interference to eastbound traffic during work hours.
- Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Boyle Avenue  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction of 1<sup>st</sup> Street with no interference to eastbound traffic during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours.
- Pleasant Avenue between Boyle Avenue and Bailey Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on Pleasant Avenue during work hours.
- Intersection of Pleasant Avenue and Boyle Avenue  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Pleasant Avenue during work hours.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Bailey Street and State Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street with no interference to eastbound traffic during work hours.
- Intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and State Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in the westbound direction on 1<sup>st</sup> Street with no interference to eastbound traffic during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on State Street during work hours.
- Boyle Avenue between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and 1<sup>st</sup> Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours.
- Boyle Avenue north of 1<sup>st</sup> Street  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Boyle Avenue during work hours.
- Bailey Street between 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Pennsylvania Avenue  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Bailey Street during work hours.
- Intersection of Bailey Street and Pennsylvania Avenue  
The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Bailey Street during work hours. The Contractor shall maintain one lane of traffic in each direction on Pennsylvania Avenue during work hours.

***The Contractor shall maintain local and emergency access during all work hours.***

This work will not interfere with pedestrian traffic, except when workers excavate in the crosswalks. Only one sidewalk may be closed at a time.
