

Construction Notice

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Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of 1st Street between Alameda Street and Mission Road

The Contractor for Metro will be relocating MCI facilities by excavating and replacing communication cables and manholes in preparation for continued construction of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Light Rail Project.

What: Utility relocation in preparation of light rail construction.

When: This activity will begin the week of October 03, 2005 and will continue for approximately two months. Work hours for this phase will be weekdays from 7:00am to 3:30pm.

Where: The utility relocation activity will take place on 1st Street between Alameda Street and the Los Angeles River Bridge.

What to Expect: The MCI Contractor will be placing cables, conduit and manholes under the existing street surface. During this work, the public can expect intermittent lane closures and intermittent restrictions on parking lanes.

The Traffic Control plan implemented for this work will be submitted by MCI/Contractor and will be subject to approval from the City of Los Angeles.

All trenches and excavations will be either backfilled or steel plated and feathered with asphalt daily so that all traffic and parking lanes are open during non-construction hours.

The Contractor will maintain access to all driveways and will maintain local and emergency access during all work hours.
