Attention Residents and Business Owners in the Vicinity of 1st Street between Alameda and Vignes Streets

The Contractor for Metro will soon begin to remove trees along the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension alignment. This work will facilitate the widening of 1st Street between Alameda and Vignes and the sidewalk restoration at the same location.

What: Tree removal

When: This activity will begin the week of November 7, 2005 and will continue for approximately four weeks. The work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7:00am-5:00pm.

Where: Trees will be removed on 1st Street between Alameda and Vignes.

**What to
Expect:**

The trees will be removed by cutting the branches and when necessary using a backhoe to remove stumps. The holes left by the tree removals will be filled, graded and covered with permeable material. There will be intermittent lane closures and restricted street parking as approved by the Department of Transportation. There may also be sidewalk restrictions and detours during this work.
