Attention Residents and Business Owners in the Vicinity of Alameda Street between Temple and 1st

The Contractor for Metro will soon begin to remove trees along the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension alignment. This work will facilitate construction of the alignment on the east side of Alameda between 1st Street and Temple.

What: Tree removal

When: This activity will begin the week of November 7, 2005 and will continue for approximately four weeks. The work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7:00am-5:00pm.

Where: Trees will be removed on Alameda between 1st Street and Temple.

**What to
Expect:**

The trees will be removed by cutting the branches and when necessary using a backhoe to remove stumps. The holes left by the tree removals will be filled, graded and covered with permeable material. There will be intermittent lane closures and restricted street parking as approved by the Department of Transportation. There may also be sidewalk restrictions and detours during this work.
