ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF THIRD STREET BETWEEN HERBERT AVENUE AND ROWAN AVENUE

Beginning Thursday, May 16, 2007, the contractor will re-stripe Third Street between Herbert Avenue and Rowan Avenue. Following the re-striping, traffic will be pushed to the north side of the street. This is necessary for the contractor to begin street restoration activities on the south side of the street.

What: Re-striping, traffic switch

When: Beginning Thursday, May 16, 2007, the re-striping of the street will be for one night only, weather permitting. After the re-striping, construction activities in this area will continue until approximately six weeks. Hours of construction will be from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. approximately.

Where: South side of Third Street between Herbert Avenue and Rowan Avenue.

What to Expect:

- Cones, concrete barriers and arrow boards will be used to re-direct traffic and minimize impacts to the community.
- Access to all homes and businesses will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access will be re-routed out of the construction zone.
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
