ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF FIRST STREET BETWEEN ALAMEDA TO VIGNES

On Tuesday, May 29, 2007, the contractor will re-stripe 1st Street between Alameda to Vignes. Following the re-striping, traffic will be pushed to the center of the street. This is necessary for the Contractor to begin working on street widening/utility work. The work on northwest corner of 1st Street and Alameda requires traffic control to extend to the west of Central.

WHAT: Re-striping and traffic switch

WHEN: Beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2007. The hours of construction will be for one night only beginning at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday evening until the morning of Wednesday, May 30, 2007 at 6:00 a.m.

WHERE: 1st Street from Central to Alameda to Vignes

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- No street parking on First Street.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Cones and arrow boards will be used to redirect traffic and to minimize impacts to the community.
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Flaggers will redirect pedestrian traffic.
- Accessibility to homes and businesses will be maintained.
