

Notice of Night Construction

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF THIRD STREET BETWEEN HERBERT AVENUE AND ROWAN AVENUE

Beginning Thursday, July 5, 2007, the contractor will re-stripe Third Street between Herbert Avenue and Rowan Avenue. Following the re-striping, westbound traffic will be pushed to the north side of the street and eastbound traffic will be pushed to the south side of the street. This is necessary for the contractor to begin work on the Guideway in the middle of the street.

What: Re-striping, traffic switch

When: Beginning Thursday, July 5, 2007, the re-striping of the street will be for one night only, weather permitting. After the re-striping, construction hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. approximately.

Where: Third Street between Herbert Avenue and Rowan Avenue.

What to Expect:

- Traffic will be pushed to the north and south of Third St.
- Parking will be maintained on the south side of the street until further notice.
- Cones, concrete barriers and electronic signs will display messages to re-direct traffic and minimize impacts to the community.
- Access to all homes and businesses will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access will be re-routed out of the construction zone.
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
