ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF FIRST STREET BETWEEN LORENA AND INDIANA

During the week of July 30, 2007 the Contractor will begin widening the north and south of First Street between Lorena and Indiana. This work consists of new curb and gutter, sidewalk, pavement, and wheel chair ramps construction.

WHAT: Street Widening

WHEN: During week of July 30, 2007 for approximately 3 months.
The hours of construction will be from 6:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Monday through Friday, and possibly weekend work.

WHERE: Both sides of First Street between Lorena and Indiana

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Street parking will be restricted on First Street.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Cones and arrow boards will be used to redirect traffic and to minimize impacts to the community.
- Driveway access to local homes and businesses will be maintained.
- K-rail will be installed on north side of the street.
- Temporary chain link fence will be installed on the north side of the street.
- Existing sidewalk will be closed, but safe pedestrian pathways and access will be provided
- During any intermittent 1st Street alley closure to El Mercado parking, access via Lorena will be maintained.
- During any intermittent closure of Velasco Street, access via Indiana and Gleason will be maintained.
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
