ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF ALAMEDA AND TEMPLE

On Monday, July 30, 2007 the Contractor will re-stripe Alameda and Temple to construct the crosswalk on the northwest corner of Temple just west of Alameda. This is necessary for the Contractor to begin working on intersection improvements.

WHAT: Re-striping and Traffic Switch

WHEN: Monday, July 30, 2007. The hours of construction will be for one night only beginning at 6:00 p.m. until Tuesday morning at 6:00 a.m.
This new traffic switch and re-striping will remain in effect for approximately 3 months.

WHERE: Alameda and Temple

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Westbound traffic on Temple will be closed.
- Westbound traffic will be detoured: north on Vignes, west on Commercial, south on Alameda, west on Temple.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane for eastbound traffic on Temple.
- Cones and arrow boards will be used to redirect traffic and to minimize impacts to the community.
- Flaggers will redirect pedestrian traffic.
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Accessibility to homes and businesses will be maintained.
