ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF THIRD STREET AND FIRST STREET

As part of the continuing construction activities for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension, the Contractor will begin construction of the next phase of the street-level rail stations. Beginning October 5, 2007 and lasting for approximately three months, the Contractor will install the canopies which will cover portions the street-level rail stations, including the Atlantic, Civic Center, Maravilla, Indiana, Pico/Aliso, and Little Tokyo/Arts District stations. During this time, construction activities will take place in the middle of the street, within the current construction zone. However, street closures may occur as equipment enters and leaves the work area.

What: Installation of canopies for street-level stations.

When: Beginning Friday, October 5, 2007, through January 11, 2008

Where: Third St. and First St.

What to Expect:
