As part of the continuing construction activities for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension, the contractor has begun construction of the Pico-Aliso Station. This construction activity includes excavation and concrete work in a contained area.

When: This activity began on Friday, October 12, 2007 and will continue until approximately 4 months, weather permitting. Approximate work hours will be Monday-Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and possibly until 6:00 p.m. if necessary.

Where: Center of 1st Street between Anderson and Utah.
