ATTENTION METRO, AMTRAK AND METROLINK PASSENGERS

As part of the continuing construction activities for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension at the Union Station property where the bridge goes over the 101 Freeway, the Contractor will begin construction of a roadway and a walkway that will cross over the Gold Line bridge. This roadway will eventually be the baggage road, pedestrian walkway, and emergency vehicle access road. To minimize construction impacts, a new temporary baggage roadway and walkway near the end of the tracks has been created.

What: Pedestrian and baggage access modification.

When: Tuesday, October 16, 2007

Where: Between Tracks 3 and 10, behind the existing Metrolink booth near the end of the tracks.

What to expect:

- New walkway will have a barrier separating pedestrians from the baggage carts.
- Signage will be available to direct pedestrians.
- Construction activities are expected to last until the completion of the baggage overpass.
- Walkway will be open 24hrs a day until work is completed.
- No vehicles will be able to enter the area from the Union Station side.
