ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF THIRD STREET AND GAGE AVENUE

Beginning Monday, October 22, 2007, the Contractor will re-stripe the Third St./Gage Ave. and Third St./Eastman Ave. intersections. The re-striping and set up of k-rail will take place during one night only. Following the new configuration of the intersection, southbound traffic on Gage Ave. will need to make a right turn at Third St., North and southbound traffic on Eastman Ave. will also need to make a right turn at Third St. Thru traffic for east and westbound traffic on Third St. will be maintained; however, left turns on Gage Ave. and Eastman Ave. will be prohibited. This configuration is necessary for the contractor to begin laying track across the intersections.

What: Traffic re-configuration

When: Monday, October 22, 2007 at 7:00 p.m., night re-striping will be for only one night. The hours of construction after the re-striping will be from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., weather permitting.

Where: Third St./Gage Ave and Third St./Eastman Ave. intersections.

What to Expect:

- Eastbound traffic will be permitted left turns onto southbound Rowan Ave.
- Northbound Rowan Ave. will re-open.
- Northbound and southbound traffic on Gage Ave will need to make a right turn at Third St.
- South and northbound traffic on Eastman Ave. will need to make a right turn at Third St.
- Access thru Third Ave. will be maintained for east and west bound traffic.
- Left turns will be prohibited at the intersections.
- Cones and arrow boards will be used to re-direct traffic.
- Access will be maintained for all residents.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained and will be redirected into a safe area out of the zone of construction.
- Fire department and emergency vehicles access will be maintained at all times.
