ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF FIRST STREET AND INDIANA

Beginning on Monday, January 14, 2008, the Contractor will re-stripe First Street at Indiana. The re-striping will take place for one night only. The Contractor will then begin utility relocation and civil improvements on the South side of First Street in preparation for rail installation. Over the following two months, Eastbound First Street will remain closed between Velasco and Alma Streets.

What: Re-striping and civil improvements

When: Monday, January 14, 2008 at 7:00 p.m., re-striping will be for only one night from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. Each day, the hours of construction for the civil improvements will be approximately from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., for an approximate period of two months, weather permitting.

Where: South side of First Street and Indiana

What to Expect:

- Indiana will be closed south of First Street; no access to or from eastbound or westbound First Street to southbound Indiana. No access to First Street from northbound Indiana.
- Westbound traffic on First Street will be maintained.
- Eastbound traffic on First Street will be closed between Velasco and Alma Avenue, except for local access.
- Eastbound thru traffic on First Street will be detoured to northbound Lorena, onto eastbound Cesar Chavez Avenue, onto southbound Rowan, back to eastbound First Street.
- Left turns will be prohibited for westbound traffic on First Street onto Indiana; right turns onto northbound Indiana will be maintained.
- Southbound traffic on Indiana will have to make a right turn onto westbound First Street.
- Northbound thru traffic on Indiana will be detoured either left or right onto 3rd Street; local access will be maintained between 3rd Street and 1st Street.
- Pedestrians will be rerouted to a safe area outside the construction zone.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
