ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF THIRD STREET AND FORD BOULEVARD

The Contractor continues to work on the construction of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension and as a result there are continuous street closures for eastbound traffic along Third St. between Ford Blvd. and Mc Donnell Ave. The closure is necessary to move equipment and materials for the canopy of the Maravilla Station and will take place the week of May 5, 2008 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

What: Canopy placement activities at Maravilla Station

When: Week of May 5, 2008

Where: Third St. between Ford Blvd. and McDonnell Ave.

What to Expect:

- Eastbound traffic will be detoured southbound on Ford Blvd., eastbound on Whittier Blvd., northbound on Arizona St, back to eastbound Third St.
- Access to all homes and businesses will be maintained
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Fire department and emergency vehicle access will be maintained
