

Construction Notice

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF FIRST STREET BETWEEN FRESNO AND LORENA STREETS

The contractor will begin the construction of the emergency exit and sidewalk excavation at the East Portal. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the north side of First Street. The duration of this construction activity is scheduled for approximately 1 month.

WHAT: Emergency exit and sidewalk excavation

WHEN: Wednesday, June 11, 2008 for 1 month. The hours of construction are from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday – Friday.

WHERE: South side of First Street between Concord and Fresno

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- One lane of traffic in each direction heading east and west will remain open during this construction activity.
- Parking on First Street will be restricted.
- Pedestrians will be rerouted to the north side of First Street.
- For the residents in the construction zone: trash pick up will remain on First Street just east of the construction zone. U.S. mail can be picked up at Hazard Postal Office, 3729 E. 1st Street; 323-262-0361.
- Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained.
