

Notice of Full Street Closure

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF FIRST STREET BETWEEN FRESNO AND LORENA

The Contractor will begin the deck removal at the East Portal. This construction activity requires a full street closure to build the roof of the underground station and finalize civil improvements such as street restoration, curb and gutter, sidewalk reconstruction, and street lighting.

What: Deck removal and civil improvements

When: Starting at 6:00 a.m. on Monday, July 14, 2008, for approximately 4 weeks. Closures will be continuous on a 24-hour basis.

Where: First Street, from Fresno Street to Lorena Street

What to expect:

- **Businesses will continue to be open during construction.**
- No vehicular access will be permitted during the closure.
- Residential will have access to their homes through the rear alley.
- Pedestrian access will be restricted on First Street from Fresno to Lorena except for local access to homes and businesses.
- There will be no access to the jogging path along First Street during construction.
- There will be no impact to mail delivery.
- Residents are encouraged to place their trash receptacles at 1st/Fresno and 1st/Lorena.
- Eastbound traffic on First Street will be detoured to southbound Evergreen Avenue, to eastbound 4th Street, to northbound Gage Avenue, to eastbound First Street.
- Westbound traffic on First Street will be detoured to northbound Gage Avenue, to westbound Cesar Chavez Avenue, to southbound Evergreen Avenue, to westbound First Street.

Temporary bus stop relocations

- Bus lines 30, 31, and 330 will stop at assigned Line 68 bus stops on Cesar Chavez Avenue.
- Eastbound bus lines 30, 31, and 330 will be detoured to northbound Evergreen Avenue, eastbound Cesar Chavez Avenue, southbound Lorena Street, to eastbound First Street.
- Westbound bus lines 30, 31, and 330 will be detoured to northbound Lorena Street, westbound Cesar Chavez Avenue, southbound Evergreen Avenue, to westbound First Street.
