The California Air Resources Board (ARB) and the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) provide comprehensive air quality compliance training courses to advance the professional development of participants throughout California. The following free courses will provide participants with an understanding of the air quality regulations and requirements associated with stationary, mobile and portable equipment emission sources in LA County.

CA ARB	Course #104: Fugitive Dust	Covers the how, what, where and health impacts of particulate matter and the problem that fugitive dust presents. This course also discusses the rules and regulations that have been adopted to control fugitive dust, as well as the methods used to determine compliance with and/or violations to these regulations.	ssl.arb.ca.gov/training/training.htm
CA ARB	CA ARB Course #101: Portable Equipment ATCM	<p>Owners or operators of portable engines and certain other types of equipment can register their units under the ARB's Statewide Portable Equipment Registration Program (PERP) in order to operate their equipment throughout California without having to obtain individual permits from local air districts. This one-day course is designed for both environmental regulators and the public, and is designed to provide information on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> > What is PERP? > Legislative history and rule development > Eligibility requirements for both engines and equipment units > PERP requirements: Identification, notification bookkeeping, etc. > Airborne Toxic Control Measures (ATCM) requirements > Inspection requirements 	ssl.arb.ca.gov/training/training.htm
CA ARB	Course #504: In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation Training	Provides an overview of the amended Off-Road Regulation, including the applicability of the regulation, requirements currently in effect and future compliance requirements. This course will also include an overview of the Diesel Off-Road Online Reporting System (DOORS).	ssl.arb.ca.gov/training/training.htm
CA ARB	Course #521.8 - Compliance Options and Reporting Requirements	Provides an overview of several new and existing regulations designed to reduce emissions from diesel vehicles used in California.	ssl.arb.ca.gov/training/training.htm
SCAQMD	Compliance Training: Dust Control in South Coast Air Basin	This three-hour training class provides a comprehensive overview of SCAQMD dust control requirements and current strategies for preventing, mitigating and controlling the release of airborne particulate matter (dust) emissions from earth-moving activities undertaken within the South Coast Air Basin. Topics covered during the training class include: Rule 201 (Permit to Construct) and 203 (Permit to Operate), Rule 401 (Visible Emissions), Rule 402 (Public Nuisance), Rule 403 (Fugitive Dust) and SCAQMD Dust Control Plan Guidelines and Approval Process.	aqmd.gov/home/programs/business/training-403-403-1-fugitive-dust
