Overview

The Metro Orange Line Extension will extend four miles north from the Metro Orange Line Canoga Station to the Metrolink/Amtrak Chatsworth Station. This dedicated busway will offer improvements to north-south mobility in the western San Fernando Valley by connecting activity centers along the corridor and connecting the Metro Orange Line with Metrolink and Amtrak service. The construction of the Metro Orange Line Extension will offer faster travel times, improved bus connections, and provide better access to destinations throughout Los Angeles County.

Project At a Glance

- > A four-mile northern extension of the Metro Orange Line, extending from the Metro Orange Line Canoga Station to the Chatsworth Station
- > Four new stations at Sherman Wy, Roscoe Bl, Nordhoff St and the Chatsworth Station
- > New platforms at the Canoga Station
- > A new bikeway and pedestrian path running parallel to the dedicated busway
- > Landscaping similar to the existing Metro Orange Line
- > A new park/ride lot at the Sherman Way Station
- > Additional parking at the Chatsworth Station
- > Elevated bridge overcrossing at Lassen St and railroad tracks to separate bus, train and auto traffic
- > Forecasted opening: summer 2012
