Community Meeting Set for Doran Street Crossing Interim Improvements

Metro invites you to attend a community meeting on March 28 in Atwater Village to learn about the Doran Street Crossing Interim Improvements that will retrofit the crossing to a one-way (westbound) use only.

The Doran Street Crossing will be retrofitted in the short-term to improve safety, including signal modifications, a new pedestrian crossing and a modified at-grade roadway for one-way (westbound) use only. These scheduled modifications resulted from the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) order calling for the closure of the street/rail at-grade crossing at West Doran Street.

The interim improvements are being performed in advance of the grade separation improvements. Separate community meetings will be held later this year to discuss the Doran Street and Broadway/Brazil Safety and Access Project that provides an overpass crossing at Salem St/Sperry St and allows the closure of the Doran Street and Broadway/Brazil at-grade crossings.
