INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE

### Introduction

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (“Metro”) generates Low Carbon Fuel Standard (“LCFS”) credits through the use of low carbon transportation fuels such as electricity and renewable natural gas. Metro will conduct periodic solicitations for the sale of LCFS credits by issuance of Request for Offers (“RFOs”).

### Solicitation Protocol

Metro will periodically issue RFOs to parties who have expressed interest in purchasing LCFS credits from Metro. Please contact the individuals listed below in order to receive notifications for current solicitations.

Offerors may provide one or more firm, fixed price bid pairs for the purchase of the LCFS credits. The price for each bid pair shall be the full, final price that the Offeror shall pay for the LCFS credits and exclude any other fees (e.g. commission fees). Awards will be made to the highest, responsible Offeror(s) within seven (7) days from the date offers are opened. Successful Offeror(s) shall make payment within five (5) days of receipt of award notice. Payment shall be made by bank wire transfer. Upon confirmation that payment has cleared, Metro shall transfer the LCFS credits to successful Offeror via LCFS Reporting Tool and Credit Bank and Transfer System (“LRT-CBTS”) online platform within five (5) business days.
