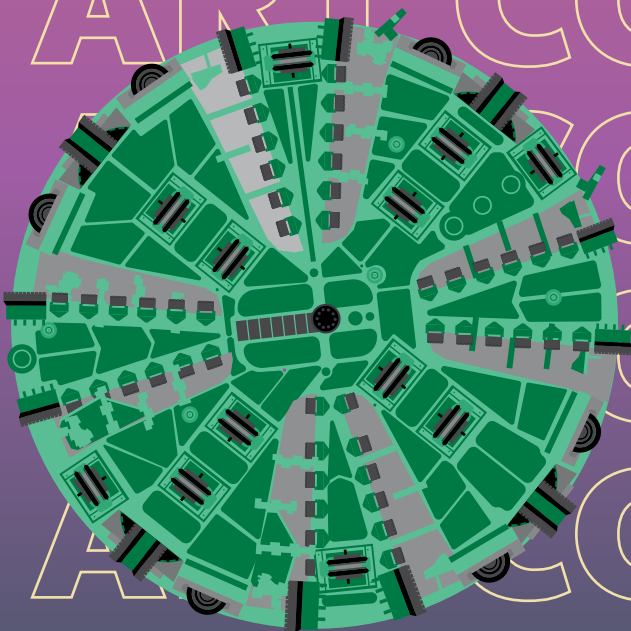

Welcome the tunnel boring machines (TBMs) that will be digging the path to the LA 2028 Summer Olympics!

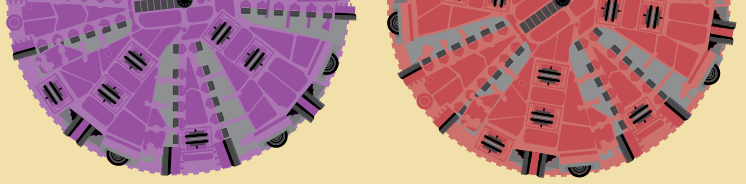

WHAT WILL THE TBMS DO?

The TBMs will be digging two parallel tunnels for the Purple Line Extension subway so that trains can travel between Westwood and the VA Hospital.

HOW TO ENTER
