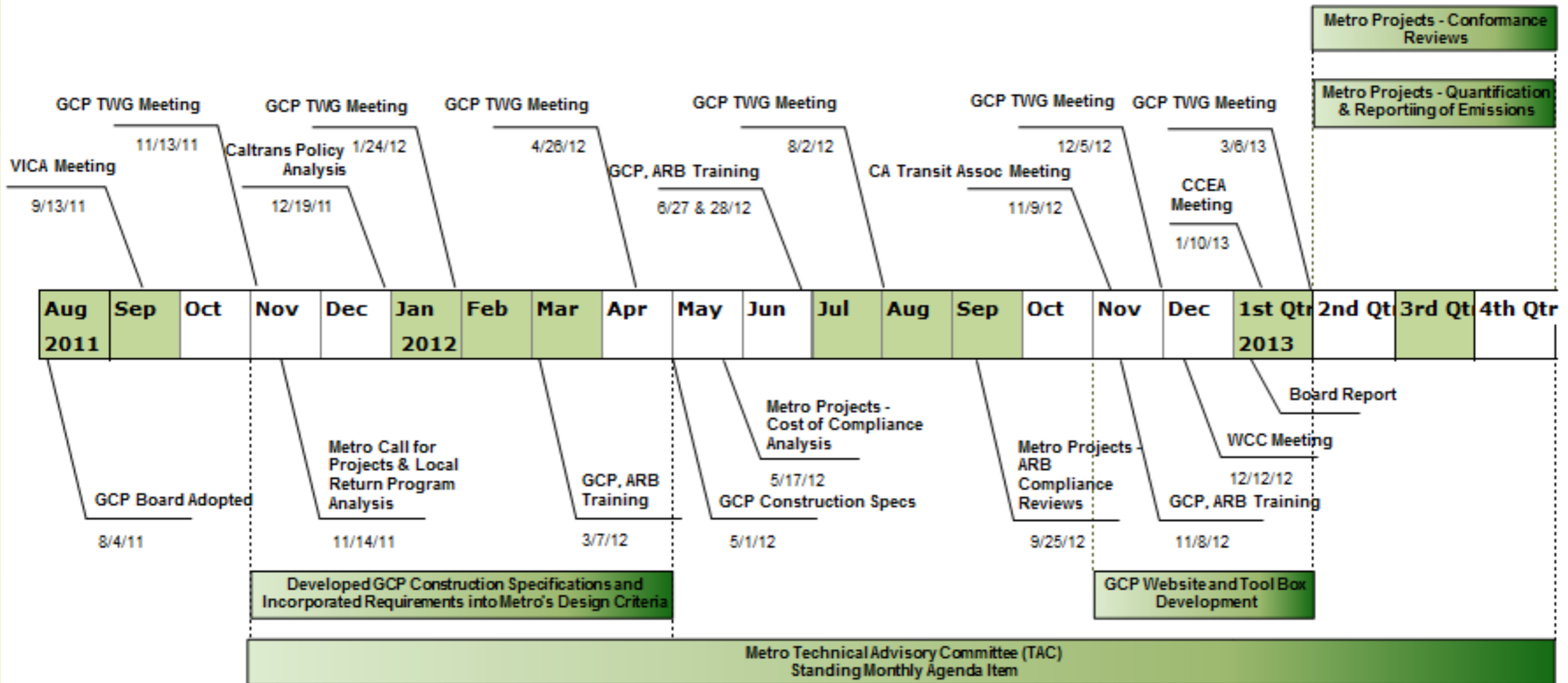

Recent Activities

- Metro's GCP has been implemented since August 2011
 - First affected project: May 2012
 - No Significant Increase to Project Costs
 - GCP Requirements incorporated in all Capital Projects
 - Crenshaw/LAX Transit Corridor Project First Major Capital Project that Cost Impact & Diesel Emissions Will Be Tracked
