Mulholland Bridge Demolition and Reconstruction

- Mulholland Bridge will be reconstructed to support the widening of the I-405 Freeway
- Demolition of south half of the Mulholland Bridge on the weekend of July 16-17, 2011, requiring full freeway closure
- Reconstruction of south half of bridge to last approximately 11 months
- Demolition and reconstruction of north half of bridge to occur thereafter

Mulholland Bridge Demolition and Reconstruction

Full Freeway Closure

- Height and long span of bridge and absence of center support column requires full freeway closure
- Freeway closure limits:
 - Northbound I-405 from 10 freeway to 101 freeway (10 miles)
 - Southbound I-405 from the 101 freeway to Getty Center Dr Ramps (4 miles)
- Full closure of the I-405 freeway is required to protect the public during bridge demolition
- July 16-17 date chosen to lessen the impact to local schools, institutions, and community during the summer months



Mulholland Bridge Demolition and Reconstruction

Incident Command Coordination

- Police, Fire, California Highway Patrol, Caltrans, and LA Dept. of Transportation.
- Local traffic handling plans and detours
- Emergency response and resource coordination
- Pre-positioned assets



Mulholland Bridge Demolition and Reconstruction

Outreach

- Local, regional, state and national outreach campaign
- Weekly email blast to 6,000 contacts
- Media campaign
- Coordination with service agencies: emergency, airports, ports, transportation, delivery services, businesses, educational institutions, and entertainment venues
- Digital message signs on freeways
